As a player Andy was an extremely competitive open-side flanker for Bath, England and the British & Irish Lions. He then went onto coaching Bath and was appointed forwards coach for England for the World Cup winning side of 2003. He was head coach of England between 2004 & 2006 before resigning and going up to Edinburgh as head coach in the summer of 2007. In his first season, he guided Edinburgh to their highest ever finish by a Scottish side in the Magners league (joint 3<sup>rd</sup>).

Andy was made head coach of the Scotland Rugby team in June 2009 and has since led them to famous wins over Argentina, Australia and Ireland as well as the recent victory against the World Champions South Africa. Scotland are currently 7<sup>th</sup> in the IRB World rankings – their highest ever placing.
